RESOLUTION NO.

APPROVING CONTINUATION WITH MODIFICATIONS OF  
AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT NO. 124

Legislator \_\_\_\_\_ offered the following resolution  
and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, Agricultural District No. 124 was approved by Resolution No. 111-04 of the Greene County Legislature on March 17, 2004; and

WHEREAS, Article 25AA, Section 303-a of the Agriculture and Markets Law of New York State provides that the County Legislative Body shall review any district created eight years after the date of its creation and every eight years thereafter; and

WHEREAS, the Greene County Legislature received notice from New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets that the eight year review of Agricultural District No. 124 must be initiated; and

WHEREAS, the Greene County Legislature through Resolution No. 315-11 conducted a 30-day public comment period which began September 26, 2011 and ended on October 26, 2011 during which modifications to the district were solicited; and

WHEREAS, proposed modifications have been reviewed by the Greene County Agricultural and Farmland Protection Board; and

WHEREAS, the Greene County Agricultural and Farmland Protection Board, after conducting an appropriate review, has prepared a report on the district review; and

WHEREAS, the recommendations by the Greene County Agricultural and Farmland Protection Board to continue Agricultural District No. 124 with modifications were discussed at a Public Hearing held in the Village of Catskill on February 15, 2012 at which no objections were voiced; and

WHEREAS, the Greene County Legislature as Lead Agency has determined that the modifications will not have a significant adverse environmental impact; and

WHEREAS, the Greene County Legislature has conducted a review of Agricultural District 124 in accordance with the requirements of Article 25AA, Section 303-a of the Agriculture and Markets Law of New York State;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that after due deliberation and pursuant to the Agriculture and Markets Law, the Greene County Legislature hereby approves the continuation with modifications of Agricultural District No. 124 with the boundaries changed as recommended in the report of the Greene County Agricultural and Farmland Protection Board.
