**INFORMATION FOR VETERANS**

**FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:**

**Q. How do I participate in this program?**

A. To participate, all you have to do is obtain an official Greene County Veteran ID Card and present it to participating merchants when you make a purchase. Be aware that other veteran and active ID Cards will be accepted by participating merchants such as a Veterans Administration Health Care Card ID Card or an active duty or retired military ID Card (DEER).

**Q. How do I get an official Greene County Veteran ID Card?**

A. To obtain a card, visit the County Clerk's Office any weekday between 9am and 1pm. If you have already filed a copy of your Discharge (Form DD-214) then all you need to present is your photo ID (Driver's License, for example).

**Q. What if my DD-214 is not already recorded at the County Clerk's Office?**

A. If your discharge has not been recorded, or you are not sure whether it has, bring an original or Certified Copy of your DD-214 to the Clerk's Office and it will be photocopied and recorded. Your original will be returned to you.

**Q. My DD-214 contains personal information that I do not wish to make public. Will my information be protected?**

A. Military Discharges recorded at County Clerk's Offices were once considered public documents. A veteran would record his DD-214 at the County Clerk's Office to make a public record of his service. Due to inappropriate use of this information in other counties, these records are now **kept private and released only to the veteran or his/her family**.

**Q. Is there any cost to participate in the program?**

A. Participation in the program is free. There is a \$5 fee to obtain a Greene County Veteran ID Card, which is only to cover the cost of the equipment and staff to produce the cards.

**Q. Where can I use my Greene County Veteran ID Card?**

A. Please follow the link on the previous page to see a list of participating merchants. As more businesses opt to participate in the program, the list will be updated, so be sure to check back periodically.
